Get to work when you graduate!

This limited time program gives high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to receive one of three healthcare certifications (Medical Assistant, Phlebotomy Technician, Certified Nursing Assistant) while attending high school. This grant opportunity covers the cost of instruction, supplies, and certifications exams.

Medical Assistant/Phlebotomy Technician

- Medical Assistant program at Eastern West Virginia Community & Technical College (EWVCTC) and Tucker County High School, two nights a week (6pm classes) and two Saturdays a month
- Phlebotomy Technician at EWVCTC, two nights a week
- One (1) semester program (August-December 2022)

Certified Nursing Assistant

- Trainings at South Branch Career & Technical Center, Hampshire High School, and Tucker County High School
- Dual Enrollment
- Students are eligible at their current institutions
- Must be enrolled in C.N.A. program at your school to be eligible for dual enrollment
