


Alumni Phone Survey



Eastern WV CTC received full accreditation from Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools in Fall 2009. However, the Learner Support Office began phone surveys to Eastern graduates in Fall Of 2007. The phone survey begins six months after students' graduation date.

Students have moved, phone numbers have changed or students' phones have been disconnected or the students are unavailable and lack of staff availability has diminished the response rate. From Fall Of 2007 to Spring of 2012, Eastern had 82 responses out of 237 graduating students. The total completers is 262. Total completers consist of students receiving an additional credential within the same graduating term. Due to the barriers of conducting a phone survey, Eastern received a 34.6% response rate.


In Spring of 2013, Eastern varied the methods used to collect the data either by phone or via survey link in an email. However for Fall 2012, the graduates were not contact either way for an unknown reason. From Fall of 2012 to Spring 2017, Eastern had 133 responses out of 566 graduating students. The total completers is 697. Eastern received a 23.4% response rate.






The survey asks the student questions in regards to employment, field of study comparable to current job position and educational goals. Eighty-one of the students are currently employed. Out of the 81 students, 57 of them are employed full-time.






Students who said they were not employed, 26% of the students stated they are actively looking for a full-time, closely relation position.




Are you looking for a position?




■ Yes ■ No ■ ■

Are you looking for full-time?





Degree Program vs. Current Position


