- A. FY 17 budget recommendations from Finance Committee FY budget-Penny Reardon, Deb Backus and Dr. Terrell
 - Dr. Terrell reminded members that the State has not finalized the budget, and that Eastern is preparing for a 10.5% budget cut for FY17 appropriations.
 - Ms. Reardon emphasized the need to maintain a 25% reserve for the 2018 HLC reaccreditation. She then presented a proposed budget for Eastern WVCTC with the following BOG Finance Committee recommendations:
 - Tuition increase of 12 percent, for \$140 per credit hour (WVCTCS average is \$148)
 - Increase Early Entrance tuition
 - Financial Aid Director position remain unfilled; contract with WVCTCS and Mary Blizzard to continue
 - Vacant Financial Aid classified position to remain unfilled
 - Office Administrator for President's office to remain part-time
 - English faculty position remain unfilled (currently grant funded)
 - Auto Tech program revamped for possible part-time faculty

- Faculty promotions to be considered after August
- No annual increase for classified staff, faculty and administrators
- Four-day work week (option)
- Freeze on tuition waivers

Mr. Lambert made a motion to adopt the budget with necessary adjustments as needed, with a second by Mr. Greenwalt. The motion passed unanimously.

A College-wide meeting will be held next week to discuss the budget updates.
