This course is offered as part of the Horticulture Management Systems Certification Track by Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College Agricultural Innovation Trainings and Certifications. **Cover Cropping and Soil Health** will provide training for beginner and experienced high tunnel producers to learn how to properly manage and crop plan for consistent production. Upon completion of this program, participants will obtain **3 contact hours**.

This co is instructed by **Lewis Jett** from **WVU Extension**.

For Ag Plant and Private Applicator Categories, certification contact hours gained from this training can be utilized for pesticide recertification credits. Each 30 minutes of contact awards 1 recertification credit for commercial applicators, which require 20 recertification credits or 10 hours of contact over a 3-year period, while private applicators need 10 recertification credits or 5 hours over a 3-year period.
