Crop Scheduling and Succession Planting is offered as part of the Horticulture Management Systems Certification micro credential by Ag Innovation at Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College. The program discusses planting dates for high tunnel crops to target specific markets, enabling growers to schedule their labor more efficiently throughout the year. Upon completion, participants will obtain **6 contact hours**.

Transportation will be available for participants from Eastern's Main Campus to the Eastern WV Community Action Agency located at 228 Clay Street in Moorefield.

The training is instructed by **Lewis Jett** from **WVU Extension**

*For **Ag Plant and Private Applicator Categories**, certification contact hours gained from this training can be utilized for pesticide **re-certification credits**. Each 30 minutes of contact awards one re-certification credit for commercial applicators, which require 20 re-certification credits or 10 hours of contact over a three-year period, while private applicators need 10 re-certification credits or five hours over a three-year period.*
