

CROP SCHEDULING AND SUCCESSION PLANTING

In this training, WVU Extension Specialist Lewis Jett will discuss planting dates for high tunnel crops to target specific markets, enabling growers to schedule their labor more efficiently throughout the year.

This course is offered as part of Eastern Ag Innovation's horticulture management systems micro credential. Those pursuing the micro credential will earn six contact hours from this training.

For Ag Plant and Private Applicator Categories, certification contact hours gained from this training can be utilized for pesticide recertification credits. Each 30 minutes of contact awards one recertification credit for commercial applicators, which require 20 recertification credits or ten hours of contact over a three-year period, while private applicators need ten recertification credits or five hours over a three-year period.
