- Three (3) additional lower-level CJ Electives (LLME): CJ 111, CJ 204, CJ 206, CJ 233, CJ 236, CJ 242, CJ 245, CJ 255, CJ 293 or CJ 295

Upper-Level Major Electives (Select four) – 12 credits:

- CJ 301, CJ 302, CJ 316, CJ 324, CJ 325, CJ 415, CJ 461, CJ 493


Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
