# Hardy County Community Foundation Vo-Tech Training Scholarships

### **Eligibility Criteria**

#### East Hardy Vo-Tech Training – Estimated Award \$1,000

- Must be a resident of East Hardy County and have completed a high school education through an East Hardy County high school or earned a General Education Development (GED) or High School Equivalency (HSE) diploma with a minimum GPA of 2.0 or GED equivalent
- Full-time attendance at an accredited vocational, technical or trade school with the intent to graduate with a degree or certification
- Must demonstrate financial need
- May be renewable

#### Bill and Stella Halterman Crane Vo-tech and Trades Scholarship - Estimated Award: \$1,500

- Graduating senior from Moorefield High School with a demonstrated passion for the trades as evidenced by relevant courses completed or employment during high school
- Full-time attendance at an accredited trade school or technical college with plans to pursue a career in a vo-tech/trade field, including automotive mechanic/technician, medical technician, electrical/electronic technician, HVAC technician, robotics technician, masonry, welding, or woodworking
- Have U. S. citizenship or legal permanent resident status
- May be renewable

#### Jerry Shingleton Scholarship - Estimated Award: \$500

- Graduating senior from a Hampshire or Hardy County high school with a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Full-time attendance at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, vocational, technical or trade school to pursue a **degree or certificate** in an **automotive field**
- Have financial need
- May be renewable

#### Process

- The student must have applied to one or more accredited post-secondary, not-for-profit institutions at the time of application. *Community Foundation scholarship awards may not be paid to for-profit institutions*.
- The student must submit the completed application along with all required documentation (refer to checklist).
- Completed applications must be submitted by June 13<sup>th</sup>. Recipients will be notified in early/mid-July
- Scholarship awards will be mailed to the school/college by July 25<sup>th</sup>.
- The Community Foundation reserves the right to reconsider scholarship awards if an applicant receives significant or additional scholarships.
