

## LPN TO RN BRIDGE PROGRAM

• Hybrid program leading to an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Nursing in preparation to sit for the NCLEX examination.



Starts in January 2026.

• Complete the program over 1 year (3 semesters) with graduation in the fall. The coursework is online with clinicals combining virtual, simulation, and in-person.

## **Admission Requirements:**

- Applicants must submit all required materials for their application to be considered complete. Only complete applications will be reviewed for admission.
- Current, Unencumbered WV or Multi-State Compact LPN License
- Residency in West Virginia or Maryland only
- Applicants with two unsuccessful attempts in prior Registered Nursing programs will not be considered.
- Minimum 2.0 college GPA (if applicable)
- TEAS score of at least 60 (valid for 3 years; remote option available)
- Current American Heart Association BLS Certification
- Completion of the following prerequisites:
- English 101
- Human Anatomy & Physiology I
- Human Anatomy & Physiology Lab I
- General Psychology
