

Message from the President Dr. Chuck Terrell

Dear Eastern Students:

Following Governor Jim Justice's statewide address Tuesday, March 17, during which he shared that West Virginia has its first confirmed case of COVID-19 (in the Eastern Panhandle), I wanted to follow up with guidance for Eastern students to do their part to prevent the spread of the disease. The overarching goals at Eastern are to <u>continue our operations</u> while <u>thinning out</u> <u>physical offices</u> as much as possible. To that end, beginning Monday, March 23, we are implementing a work-from-home plan for Eastern staff and faculty.

Online Instruction

Earlier this week, faculty and Learner Support Services provided information with a plan to **cancel face-to-face classes and complete the 2020 spring semester through online instruction.** It is the intent of the College to complete the remainder of the semester using Blackboard and other online resources.

Some Eastern classes will have access to the Moorefield Campus and Eastern Technology Center for testing, hands-on labs, and other activities to complete course requirements.

- **Nursing students** will receive communications and instructions from nursing faculty regarding testing and clinical.
- Electromechanical and Wind Technology students will receive communications and instructions from Eric Putze.
- Workforce Education short-term training will receive communications and instructions from Melissa Shockey and/or their instructor.

Students accessing the Moorefield campus and/or Eastern Technology Center **will be divided into groups, less than ten.** Please follow standard hygiene practices when you are at an Eastern facility.

- Using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not readily available.
- Staying home when you are sick. If you become sick, call your medical provider for guidance before you go to a medical office.
- Covering the nose and mouth with an elbow or a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Practice social distancing. Seating in a classroom will be assigned to provide social distancing.
- Following CDC's recommendations for using a facemask:
 - CDC does not recommend that people who are well to wear a facemask to protect themselves from respiratory diseases, including COVID-19.
