

Potomac Highlands Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students Application

The Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students will be awarded to selected recipients in the form of a waiver for tuition and fees associated with attendance at Eastern WV Community and Technical College (excluded are the following fees: book, on-line class fee, lab, and other student fees) for one academic year, with a review after the first semester before renewal. The recipient of the scholarship shall meet the following initial requirements:

- Have a high school diploma or TASC certificate or home school diploma;
- Be 24 years old or older;
- Plan to attend Eastern WV Community and Technical during the 2021-2022 academic year;
- Enroll in one of the transfer degree programs (AA/AS) not eligible for the WV Invests Grant (www.wvinvests.org)
- Complete the following required application which is to be neatly handwritten or typed. Additional sheets may be attached as needed;
- Complete the 2122 FAFSA and any other documents needed by financial aid and admissions.

After completing one semester of study at Eastern WV Community and Technical College the student is expected to meet the following requirements for renewal of the award for the spring semester:

- Be attending Eastern WV Community and Technical College at least at half-time enrollment for the spring semester;
- Obtain a 2.5 or higher grade point average, as of the end of the first semester of study at Eastern; and
- Complete all credit hours attempted;
- Attend two (2) recruiting events each semester in the student's "home" county (events must have prior approval from a representative of Learner Support Services);

Applications may be submitted by mailing the completed application form to Eastern WV Community and Technical College, Scholarship Committee, 316 Eastern Drive, Moorefield, WV 26836. All applications must be postmarked by **August 7, 2021**. Final selection and award determination will be made by a scholarship review committee.
