## **Nursing Instructor (Part-Time) – REVISED 05/19/2021**

Position: Part-time Nursing Instructor, Adjunct faculty

**Location:** Works up to 24 hours per week as assigned by the EWVCTC Nursing Program Director in classroom, clinical and laboratory settings. This position reports to the Nursing Program Director.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Teach and perform professional supervisory nursing practice in the care of the physically and mentally ill.
- Work involves teaching and responsibility for supervising the provision of quality nursing care given at the facility
- Responsible for maintaining the quality and adequacy of nursing practice for recognizing and assisting in solving professional, administrative and supervisory problems in an assigned area.
- Position exercises considerable judgment in applying professional knowledge in teaching and solving nursing problems within established policies and practices and is reviewed by the supervisor through conferences, reports and observation of results obtained.

## Minimum Qualifications Requirements: Education & Experience

In accordance with Article 7. Registered Professional Nurses – §30-7-1. Definitions. §30-7-5a. Schools of nursing faculty requirements.

Part-time nursing faculty members shall:

- (1) Have a graduate degree with a major in nursing; have a bachelor's degree with a major in nursing and be enrolled in a graduate degree program with a major in nursing within one year of employment as a faculty member; or have a bachelor's degree with a major in nursing and at least two years of direct patient care experience in nursing;
- (2) Have evidence of current experience in nursing practice and education sufficient to demonstrate professional competence. For faculty with less than two years' experience in education, the nursing program administrator will submit to the board mentoring and orientation plans as defined by board guidelines and function under the guidance of a faculty member fully qualified in the specific teaching area and professional competence; and
- (3) Have credentials which verify status as a registered professional nurse in West Virginia.
- (c) The board may grant an exception to the requirements in §30-7-5a (a) and §30-7-5a (b) of this code for faculty members who have qualifications other than those set forth in these subsections which are acceptable to the board.
