The WVRCA is a four-day intensive training program. Students then complete 16 clinical training hours as arranged by Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College through the Potomac Highlands Guild, Moorefield, WV.

Recovery Coaches promote recovery by removing barriers and obstacles to recovery and serving as personal guides and mentors for people seeking or already in recovery.

The WV Recovery Coach Academy uses CCAR instructional material and focuses on providing individuals with the skills needed to guide, mentor and support anyone who would like to enter into or sustain long-term recovery from an addiction to alcohol or other drugs. The WVRCA prepares participants by helping them to actively listen, ask really good questions, and discover and manage their own issues.

- Describe the role of the Recovery Coach and functions
- List the components, core values and guiding principles of recovery
- Build skills to enhance relationships
- Explore many dimensions of recovery and recovery coaching
- Discover attitudes about self-disclosure and sharing your story
- Understand the stages of recovery
- Describe the stages of change and their applications
- Increase their awareness of culture, power and privilege
- Address ethical and boundary issues
- Experience recovery wellness planning
- Practice newly acquired skills

This training is for anyone who is interested in becoming a Recovery Coach. If your profession involves the recovery field, you may want to consider the West Virginia Recovery Coach Academy. This training utilizes a dynamic approach to learning that blends both process and content.
