Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents (if you are a dependent student) reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office. If you are a dependent student, at least one parent must sign this worksheet. Based on your answers on this worksheet we may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
