- 4. Format reports according to American Association of Medical Transcription (AAMT) guidelines.
- 5. Proofread and edit reports meticulously.
- 6. Identify and appropriately mark items that require the supervisor's and/or dictator's attention.
- 7. Research and/or verify patient information for accuracy.
- 8. Apply research skills to appropriate situations.
- 9. Use appropriate reference materials efficiently for accurate completion of reports.
- 10. Apply pertinent medicolegal polices and procedures when necessary in the transcription process.
