

The WV Invests grant allows students to take immediate advantage of the state's offer to cover the cost of tuition of certain programs at Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College (Eastern).

WHAT IS IT?

WV Invests is a state-funded financial aid program for students who wish to complete programs in high demand fields at participating public community or technical colleges and universities.

HOW IT WORKS

Regardless of whether a student has just completed high school or is interested in a career change, WV Invests can help get the credentials they need to enter into a rewarding career while saving a significant amount of money.

Students apply to Eastern and state their interest in completing an eligible program.

After filling out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa and applying for available federal and state financial aid, students can take advantage of the WV Invests grant program to cover the remaining balance of the cost of their tuition each term.

Students must first seek out scholarships and grants to pay for school. WV Invests will pay the tuition balance not covered by any grants awarded. The grant does not cover the cost of books, living expenses, fees or food. Applicants must be a West Virginia resident for at least a year prior to applying and must commit to living in West Virginia for at least two years after graduation. The student must have earned a high school diploma or equivalent. Students must not have completed a degree program or have 90 attempted credit hours from previous college coursework. The student will need to complete two hours of community service each semester, early linear teachers a drugtest prior to each academic term. enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, maintain a 2.0 GPA and agree to a drug test prior to each academic term.
