Students must seek out scholarships and grants to pay for school. WV Invests will pay the tuition balance not covered by any grants awarded. The grant does not cover the cost of books, living expenses, non-academic fees, or food. Applicants must be a West Virginia resident for at least a year prior to applying and must commit to living in West Virginia for at least two years after graduation. The student must have earned a high school diploma or equivalent. Students must not have completed a degree program or have 90 attempted credit hours from previous college coursework. The student will need to complete two hours of community service each semester, enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, maintain a 2.0 GPA and agree to a drug test prior to each academic term.
